GUAM/CNMI SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT
Fuel Surcharge to Decrease – from 47% to 44% on September 25th

Dear Valued Customer,

Horizon Lines will decrease its Fuel Adjustment Factor in the Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) trade by 3 percentage points, from 47% to 44%, effective Sunday, September 25, 2011. The decrease has been filed with the Surface Transportation Board and covers Horizon Lines tariffs HRZD 353, HRZD 344 and HRZD 961. These tariffs govern shipments moving between the continental U.S. and Guam/CNMI.

Horizon Lines will continue to closely monitor fuel costs and will adjust the Fuel Surcharge as trends warrant.
